Important note: Please note that lesson times are subject to change right until the last minute. Outside French school holidays the ski school reserves the right to cancel group lessons should numbers be insufficient. For peak periods (Christmas/New Year, February half-term and Easter), we strongly recommend that you book as early as possible and in any case at least 6 weeks prior to the required dates. Morning lessons tend to get booked up first and therefore we may only be able to offer afternoon classes within 6 weeks of departure. In some resorts English speaking instructors may not always be available, particularly at peak times.

¹ Mont de la Lune = Montgenevre + Clavière + Cesana ~ 110km of pistes. For complete beginners, please note that there is also a slightly cheaper lift pass covering Montgenèvre ski area only (95km) although we cannot pre-book this so it has to be bought in resort (approx €40/adult/day, €28/child). The full 'Via Lattea/Milky Way' lift pass covering 400km of pistes is also to be arranged locally.			
** Mons de la Lune-Galaxie lift pass allow you to ski for 2 of the 6 days that the pass is valid for in Via Lattea (Italy - linked by lifts from Montgenevre) and 1 of the 6 days in Serre-Chevalier, Puy St Vincent, Les 2 Alpes, l'Alpe d'Huez + preferential rates on the sledge rides once during your stay (valid once, not available on Saturdays nor Sundays). <u>From 5/4/26, only Montgenevre area (Derniers Virages, 95km of pistes) is available, 6 day Adult £176, Child £143, Senior £165.</u>
